





LATE 19TH CENTURY

15 miles west of Uptown Charlotte, nestled along the banks of the South Fork of the Catawba River, McAdenville was established in the late 19th centrury as a small but industrious town centered around McAden Mills.







1884

In 1884, McAden Mills became one of the first in the South to install electric lighting, a major milestone in Southern industry. This early innovation lit up the town, symbolizing progress and giving McAdenville a unique reputation.







1956

In 1956, the mill owners took their legacy of light a step further, decorating nine trees with holiday lights and sparking a tradition that would grow year after year.

TODAY

Today, McAdenville is celebrated as Christmas Town USA, drawing hundreds of thousands of vistors each December to enjoy its vibrant holiday displays. The entire town glows with festive lights, honoring a legacy of warmth and wonder that began over a century ago.
